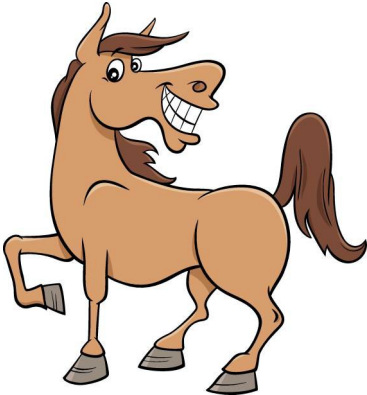
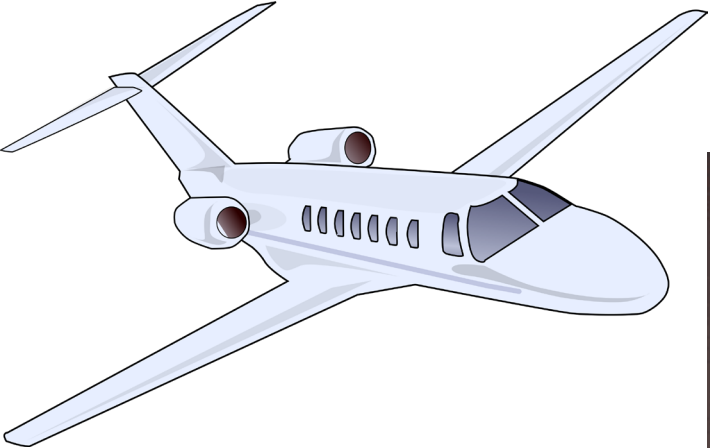

My first car – 1968 Chevy Nova SS

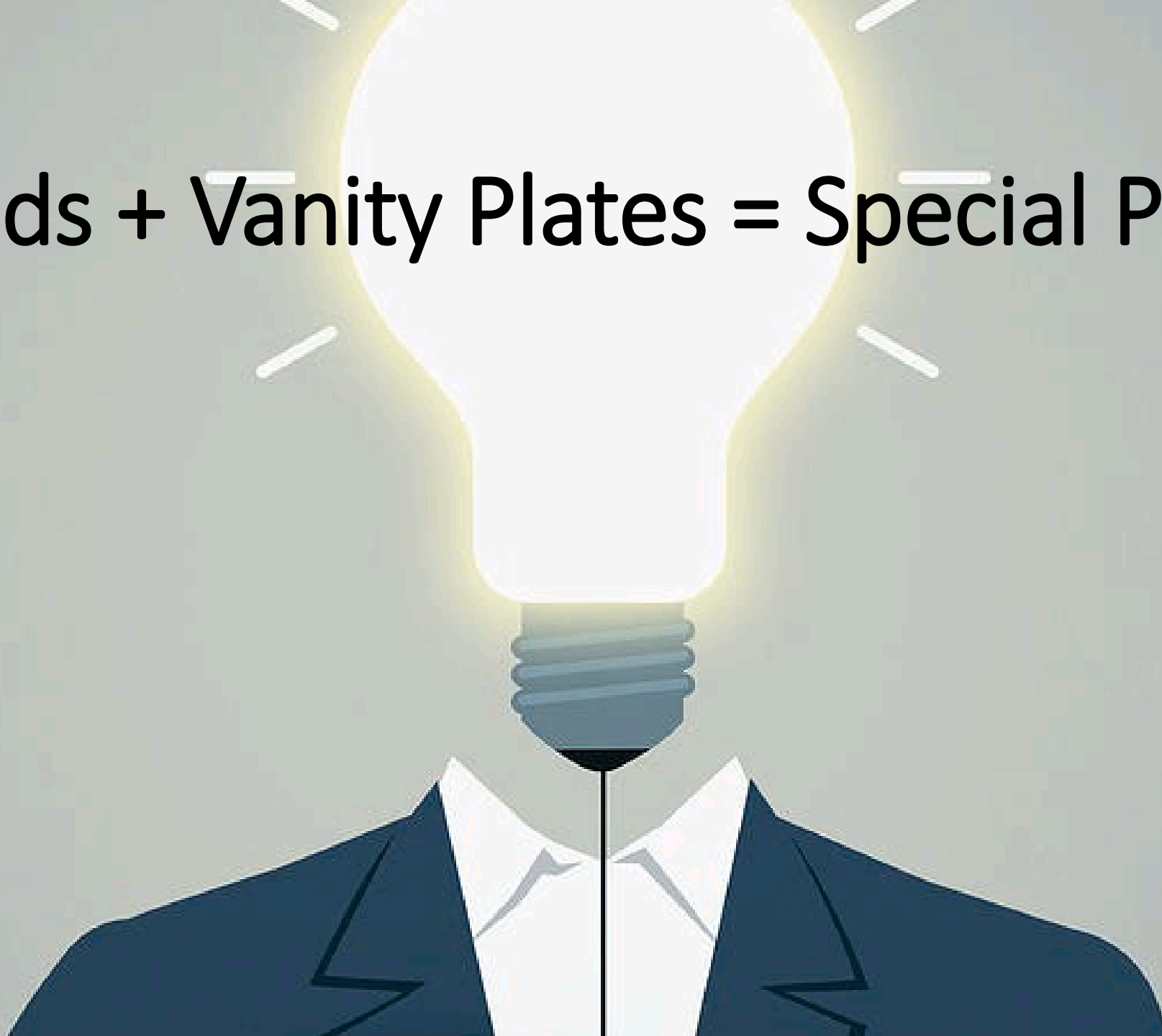

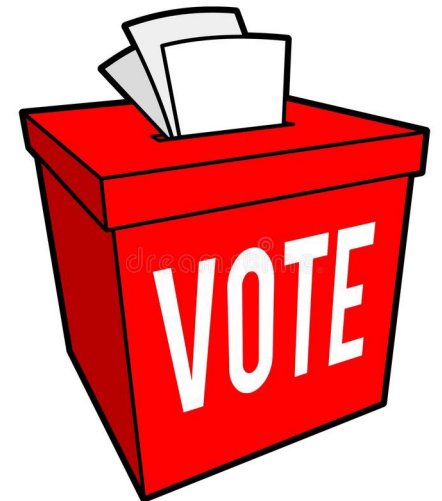
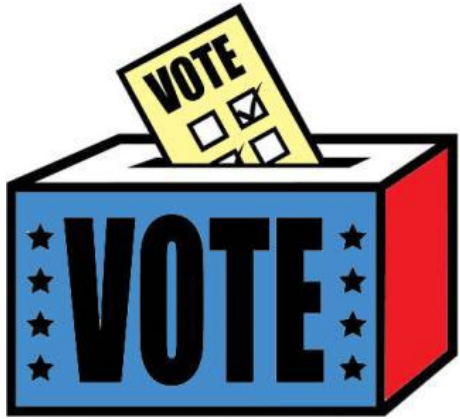
Option #4
